1. Maintenance Committee – Ray Francoeur *attached. Ray updated on new sinks and taps in men's bathroom, thanks to Judi H and your contractor. Eco-Air conducted the annual HVAC Inspection, new belts and filters. Waiting for estimate concerning capacitor using extra electricity. Hanging light in lower hall had outlet replaced thanks to Gary.

New light fixtures in lady's downstairs bathroom supplied by Judi H an installed by Gary.

Estimate for \$4,325 plus 5% tax for taking care of roof issues. The issues with the downspout by garbage container still need attention. Discussion took place re this coming from 2024

Maintenance Budget vs. being presented at GMM for approval. Sherry spoke to this matter.

Garbage container has been painted and looks spectacular, thanks to Bill McKay.

Fire escape door from back stairwell to outside is sticking – building shift or frame sag – slated for repair.

34 Multi-Loc (big) Keys held by various members and renters. Before January 31 2025 a new key list will be set up by Debbie Deighton to find out who has these keys.

We are having trouble with tables falling apart. This pertains mainly to the newer ones which are lighter than the old, and not so stable. Gary and Bill have been repairing as needed, but plastic in the tables is too weak for our purposes. New tables should be heavier.

Discussion took place. Al got prices from other places. We have 22 and 3 to 5 new ones to be purchased.

Chairs that seem to be falling apart usually need the rubber backstops which we have in stock. (We have 166.) Do not throw old chairs out. Put them aside where they will not be used and we will try to refit them.

Clean-up crews required after events.
